Why Jornaleros?

In Spanish Jornaleros is the name given to a person that works and gets paid each day for their labor. Usually is a field worker or someone that works in construction. We invite Young Adults to feel that they too are active Jornaleros of the Kingdom of God. We are invited each day to do our part to bring forth the mercy, hope and love to those around us. Together with Jesus, Young Adults, Jóvenes, can make the Kingdom of God present.
